

MENTORS NEEDED AT PCES



DID YOU KNOW? Students in a mentoring program are:

- 53% less likely to skip school
- 46% less likely to begin using illegal drugs
- 33% less likely to hit someone
- More likely to increase their grades and raise their goals

Who: Caring adults who can share 45 minutes of their time each week for a 1 year commitment.

What: A mentor is an adult who, along with parents, provides young people with support, friendship and reinforcement. Mentors are good listeners, people who care, and want to help young people develop existing strengths.

Where: Pike County Elementary School

Why: All students could benefit from having a mentor.

1. Must have an approved background check.
2. Go to Counselor's Corner on PCES website, print off mentor questionnaire, complete questionnaire and return to Patti Hester, School Counselor, P.C.E.S.
